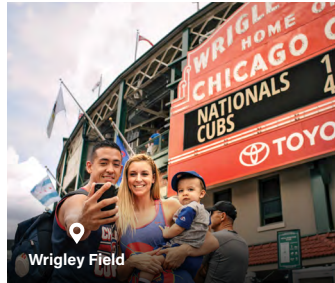

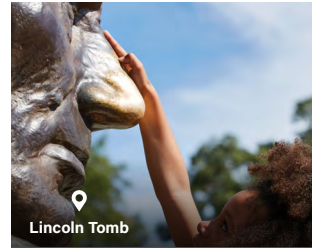


Culinary:

Illinois' Frank Lloyd Wright Trail:

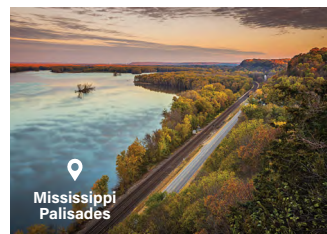
Illinois' Frank Lloyd Wright Trail is a self-guided architectural adventure featuring 13 Wright-designed buildings throughout the state, all open to the public. The [Frederick C. Robie House](#) in Chicago and [Unity Temple](#) in Oak Park are now designated UNESCO World Heritage sites.

Historic Main Street – Galena:

Nestled near the Mississippi River, the quaint small town of Galena makes for the perfect getaway no matter the season.

[Galena's Historic Main Street](#) boasts more than 125 independently owned shops and restaurants. Visitors can glide along the Galena River in a kayak or enjoy skiing at

[Chestnut Mountain Resort](#) in the winter. The town is located along the [Great River Road](#), which you can explore via a new [EV-friendly itinerary](#).



Great River Road:

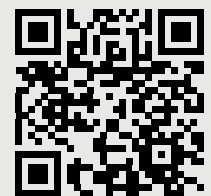
Follow the Great River Road, one of seven scenic byways, as it stretches 2,000 miles along the Mississippi River through 10 states. In Illinois, this 550-mile [All-American Road](#) offers striking vistas, especially scenic in the fall, and is a popular spot for eagle watching

in winter. Explore the beauty of historic Galena, enjoy views at [Mississippi Palisades State Park](#) in Savanna, and delve into the history of John Deere in the Quad Cities. Discover Quincy's architecture and visit Alton, the only place in America where the iconic Route 66 meets the Great River Road.

- Start your Route 66 journey in downtown Chicago at the iconic "Begin" sign before heading south to tour the [Old Joliet Prison](#), where the popular Blues Brothers movie was filmed.
- Visit the [Gemini Giant](#) Muffler Man at its new location, South Island Park in Wilmington.
- Take a selfie in front of the [Route 66 Shield Mural](#) in Pontiac and visit the new American Giants Museum in Atlanta.
- Visit Springfield's Motorheads for the world's largest Route 66 sign and [Shea's Gas Station Museum](#), a restored Texaco service station.
- Explore the [Legends Neon Sign Park](#) in Springfield and the new [It's Electric Sign Park](#) in Granite City, showcasing historic Route 66 signs.

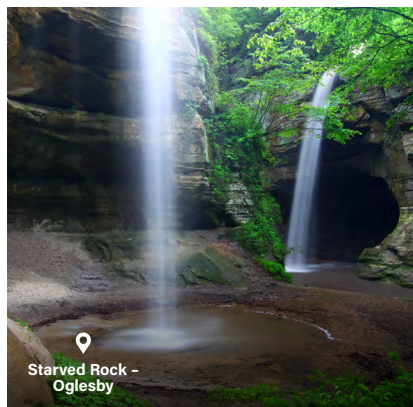

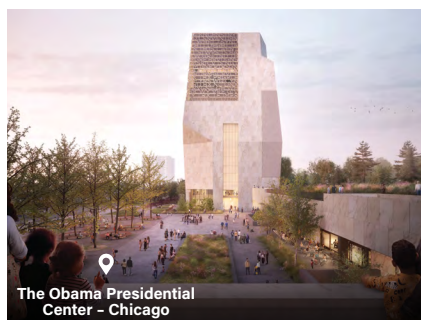
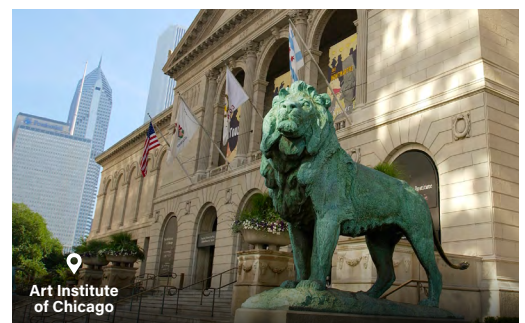
