Historic Main Street - Galena:

Nestled near the Mississippi River, the small town of Galena, celebrating its Bicentennial in 2026, makes for the perfect getaway, no matter the season.

Galena's Historic Main Street boasts more than 125 independently owned shops and restaurants. Visitors can glide along the Galena River in a kayak or enjoy skiing at Chestnut Mountain Resort in the winter. The town is located along the Great River Road, which can be explored via a new EV-friendly itinerary.

Illinois' Frank Lloyd Wright Trail:

Illinois' Frank Lloyd Wright Trail is a self-guided architectural adventure featuring 12 Wright-designed buildings throughout the state, all open to the public. The Frederick C. Robie Housee in Chicago and Unity Temple in Oak Park are now designated as UNESCO World Heritage sites.

Shawnee National Forest

Located in Southern Illinois, nestled between the Ohio and Mississippi rivers, Shawnee National Forest features hiking trails through canyons and forest canopies. Enjoy stunning views at **Garden of the Gods** and experience thrilling activities, including rock climbing, ziplining and wildlife photography. Spend the night relaxing in treehouses at **Timber Ridge Outpost & Cabins.**



Mississippi Palisades

Great River Road:

Follow the Great River Road, one of seven Illinois scenic byways, as it stretches 2,000 miles along the Mississippi River through 10 states.

This 550-mile All-American Road features stunning views, especially vibrant in the fall, and is a popular spot for eagle watching in the

winter. Enjoy the views at Mississippi Palisades State Park in Savanna, and delve into the history of John Deere in the Quad Cities. Discover Quincy's architecture and visit Alton, the only place in America where the iconic Route 66 meets the Great River Road.

- Start your Route 66 journey in downtown Chicago at the iconic "Begin" sign before heading south to tour the <u>Old Joliet Prison</u>, where the popular Blues Brothers movie was filmed.
- Visit the <u>Gemini Giant</u> Muffler Man at its new location, in South Island Park, Wilmington. Be sure to check out the <u>Landing Pad</u>, a new Route 66 souvenir shop just steps away from the Gemini Giant!
- Take a selfie in front of the <u>Route 66 Shield Mural</u> in Pontiac and visit the new <u>American Giants Museum</u> in Atlanta.
- Visit Springfield's Motorheads for the world's largest Route 66 sign and Shea's Gas Station Museum, a restored Texaco service station.
- Explore the <u>Legends Neon Sign Park</u> in Springfield and the new <u>It's Electric Sign Park</u> in Granite City, showcasing historic Route 66 signs.
