Chicago From world-class museums, to shopping along the Magnificent Mile to one-of-a-kind outdoor spaces like Millennium Park, which is celebrating its 20th Anniversary in 2024 - there is something for everyone in Chicago. Take in a sky-high view from one of Chicago's thrilling observation decks – Skydeck Chicago or 360 CHICAGO. Snap a selfie at Cloud Gate, commonly referred to as "The Bean." Stroll down Chicago's Riverwalk, stopping for a drink along the way. Savor mouthwatering deep-dish pizza and listen to live music – including classic Chicago blues and jazz – at iconic venues. Illinois Frank Lloyd Wright Trail

The Illinois Frank Lloyd Wright Trail
is a self-guided architectural adventure featuring 13 Wright-designed buildings throughout the state, all open to the public. The Frederick C. Robie House and Unity Temple in Oak Park are now designated UNESCO World Heritage sites.

Shawnee National Forest
The Shawnee National Forest in southern Illinois sits between the Ohio and Mississippi rivers and is filled with hiking trails that meander through canyons under forest canopies. Garden of the Gods, a breathtaking overlook, offers spectacular views of towering sandstone cliffs formed millions of years ago. Experience thrilling outdoor adventures such as rock climbing, ziplining and wildlife photography tours, as well as a unique glamping experience at the newly-opened Shawnee Hills Glamping property.

Historic Main Street – Galena Nestled near the Mississppi River, Galena offers breathtaking views and plenty of stops to explore the great outdoors all year round including kayaking along the Galena River. Visitors can travel the Great River Road with a new EV-friendly itinerary.

- Stop in Springfield for a visit to Motorheads, a restaurant and museum that is home to the world's largest <u>Route 66</u> sign and a new live entertainment venue, the Motordome!
- Experience the new <u>Legends Neon Sign Park</u> at the Illinois State Fairground in Springfield. The park is an homage to the incredible signs found along the Mother Road.

Alpine Coaster at Aerie's Resort in Grafton

This thrilling new ride – the first of its kind in Illinois – features two-person sleds that travel down the hillside over 3,000 feet of track at speeds up to 25 miles per hour. Visitors can travel through the seasonal foliage that Grafton is known for, and twist and turn around the landscape.

Southern Illinois Crossroads Eclipse Festival

Southern Illinois University in Carbondale will host one of the largest solar eclipse viewing events at its football stadium hosted by Mat Kaplan of Planetary Radio. Viewers will experience a total eclipse for 4 minutes and 9 seconds, one of the longest durations across the U.S.

American Giants Museum in Atlanta - NOW OPEN

The new American Giants Museum (AGM) presents the story of International Fiberglass which produced giant, fiberglass statues designed as roadside advertising pieces in the 1960s - commonly referred to as Muffler Men or American Giants. The AGM will house the largest collection of Muffler Men anywhere along the length of Route 66 from Chicago to Santa Monica, including an extremely rare 24-foot-tall TEXACO Big Friend giant.

Illinois State Fair Route 66 Experience featuring Legends Neon Sign Park in Springfield – NOW OPEN

This self-guided Route 66 experience includes vintage billboards, a drive-in movie theater and the Legends Neon Sign Park where visitors can bask in the bright lights of the Mother Road 365 days a year.
