## 20 Instagram-Worthy Places in Illinois include (in alphabetical order):

Anderson Japanese Gardens (Rockford)

Inspired by calm and tranquility, the 12-acre award-winning landscape is comprised of koi-filled ponds, winding paths, gentle streams, cascading waterfalls.

• Baha'i House of Worship (Wilmette)

Near the shores of Lake Michigan, the Baha'i House of Worship is the oldest surviving temple of its kind. With walls of lace-like ornamentation and 135-foot dome, the temple offers a scene of unsurpassed beauty.

• Bell Smith Springs (Shawnee National Forest)

One of the most beautiful recreation areas in the Shawnee National Forest, Bell Smith Springs is a hidden gem boasting a series of clear streams surrounded by sandstone bluffs.

Cave-in-Rock State Park (Cave-in-Rock)

This park in southern Illinois, overlooking the Ohio River, is known for the 55-foot wide cave that was carved out of the limestone rock by water thousands of years ago.

• Chicago Botanic Garden (Glencoe)

Climb a waterfall, cross bridges spanning sparkling lakes and soak in 27 stunning gardens throughout the seasons.

• Cloud Gate ("The Bean" Chicago)

The centerpiece of Chicago's Millennium Park, Cloud Gate (aka "The Bean") is a mirrored public sculpture and a must-have photo opportunity for locals and visitors.

• Crown Brew Coffee Co. (Carterville)

This cozy Southern Illinois coffee shop specializes in making incredible handcrafted lattes with photo-worthy designs and delicious pour over coffee.

• Garden of the Gods (Shawnee National Forest, Herod)

Millions of years in the making, the Garden of the Gods is the most visited site in the Shawnee National Forest with spectacular views of dramatic rock formations and cliffs.

Grafton SkyTour (Grafton) \*Opening June 1

This summer visitors can reach new heights riding the new Grafton Sky Tour, a gondola ride at Aerie's Resort that will offer incredible bird's eye views of the Great River Road, Mississippi River and Pere Marquette State Park.

• Historic Main Street (Galena)

With more than 125 unique boutiques, eateries, wineries and galleries, Historic Main Street in the quaint downtown of Galena is the perfect backdrop for a snapshot.

• <u>Illinois State Capitol Rotunda</u> (Springfield)

Located within the picturesque Illinois State Capitol is a magnificent rotunda featuring intricate glass designs and eye-catching colors – it's impossible to take a bad picture!

• <u>John Deere Pavilion</u> (Moline)

Climb aboard vintage John Deere tractors to snap a fun and rustic pic with family and friends at the John Deere Pavilion.

• Matthiessen State Park (Oglesby/Starved Rock Country)

From incredible rock formations to scenic hiking trails and unusual wildlife, this is a picture-perfect paradise for explorers and lovers of the great outdoors.

Morton Arboretum (Lisle)

The Morton Arboretum is the champion of trees, a living museum and an engaging 1,700-acre garden. Don't forget to go troll hunting (and pose for a selfie) for an unforgettable experience.

- Navy Pier (Chicago)
  - The pride of Chicago's lakefront, Navy Pier is a bright and colorful landmark known for its iconic Ferris Wheel along with food, entertainment and cultural attractions.
- Pontiac Visitors Center Route 66 Mural (Pontiac)
  - A road trip down Route 66 would be incomplete without a photo in front of the iconic Route 66 Mural adorned on the brick building that houses the Route 66 Museum at the Pontiac Visitors Center.
- Prairie Fruits Farm & Creamery (Champaign)
  - This goat dairy farm is known for its award-winning cheese and artisan gelato. It's the perfect place to sit back and enjoy a peaceful evening on the prairie and even play with some goats too!
- The Rookery (Chicago)
  - This Chicago landmark is included on Illinois' Frank Lloyd Wright Trail. Its elaborate main lobby and light court were renovated by the famed architect in 1905. Step inside and you'll see why it's known as one of the most spectacular interior spaces in Illinois.
- Six Flags Great America (Gurnee)
  - A destination that's fun for the whole family, Six Flags Great America is filled with bright colors, giant roller coasters and Hurricane Harbor that offers 30 soaking water rides.
- <u>Skydeck Chicago The Ledge</u> (Chicago)
   Show your followers the view from the top of Chicago while standing on The Ledge at Skydeck in Willis Tower, the tallest building in the city.
